PROJECTS UPDATE

n an effort to reduce our waiting list and provide more families with quality childcare, one of the initiatives from our most recent capital campaign was to expand our program to serve an additional 100 children. We are excited to be moving forward with the expansion of the Early Childhood Education program on our main campus. It was determined that the best space to renovate into classrooms is our current maintenance and storage area in the basement of our gym building. Therefore, we will be relocating our maintenance shop to another part of campus and then renovating their current space into fun, functional classrooms. We hope to have all renovations complete by Summer 2020.

Another exciting project we are working on is expansion of our Transitional Living program. This program is designed to assist youth "aging out" of the foster care system. We provide housing, counseling, and training in basic life skills. An anonymous donor who has a heart for young adults in this situation recently made a very generous donation to help increase the number we serve in this program. After a short search, we found a six-unit apartment building under construction that will perfectly serve our needs. We have already started accepting applications from youth for these new apartments and hope to begin moving residents in by mid-October.


